

CHASELL TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING – SEPTEMBER 14, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor Dave Mattson.

PRESENT: June Michaelson-Haataja, Ryan Kuntze, Dave Mattson, Kelly Holmes, Dan Palosaari

MINUTES: The August minutes were approved per motion by Kelly Holmes, support by Ryan Kuntze.

TREASURER’S REPORT: The treasurer’s report was approved per motion by Dan Palosaari, support by Dave Mattson. The treasurer’s report and the clerk’s financial report are attached to the minutes.

AGENDA: The agenda was approved per motion by June Michaelson-Haataja, support by Dan Palosaari.

PAYMENT OF BILLS: The payment of bills was approved per motion by Ryan Kuntze, support by Dave Mattson.

CORRESPONDENCE REVIEW:

- (1) A letter was received from Elmer Liimatta complaining about neglected property.
- (2) Notice was received regarding the new drop box placed in front of Superior National Bank.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: Fire Chief Curt Judson reported one call. He informed that, after meeting with the township insurance agent, Chassell Township was upgraded to 6 from 7. Outlying areas will remain at 9. The upgrade was due to an improvement in the water system.

FIRST RESPONDERS: Director EMT Derrick Verran reported 7 calls.

DPW: Joe Youngman reported that the water system has been improved with 39 hydrants flushed.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Brian Waters submitted a list of members and officers. A status report on Pike Bay Remediation Work was submitted.

UPEA REPORT: The Half Moon Beach ditching easements are recorded as reported by Chris Holmes. Work will begin in the spring.

NEW BUSINESS:

- (1) A request was made by Assessor Mark Maki to authorize a \$50 filing fee, payable to him, for future land division reviews. No action taken.
- (2) A lengthy, heated discussion (with 70 guests present) was held re: the re-vote to be held at the General Election. Per motion by Dave Mattson, support by Ryan Kuntze any proposal dealing with policy or taxation shall be placed in the election with the highest predicted turnout, within the time period necessary for the decision to be made – ideally a General Election.
