- 1. Call to Order 7:07

- 2. Pledge of Allegiance
- 3. Approval of the Agenda. Brian move, Doug second
- 4. Reading and Approval of the Minutes , Keith moves to approve with changes, Brian seconds
- 5. Public Comments
  - a. none present
- 6. Road Commission Report
  - a. Governor is trying to pass a tax increase, except it would go to the state not local.
  - b. County was approved to purchase a small paver that the County crews will use for patch jobs. Potential a low cost option for Chassell as we'd only have to pay for materials, not labor.
- 7. Old Business
  - a. Chassell Township Logo
    - i. No update
  - b. Chassell Mercantile Update
    - i. A clear process for filing complaints has been established.
    - ii. The owner listed the property for sale on Craigslist so there is currently a lien on the property. If sold, the Township would then get paid.
  - c. Blight Ordinance Survey
    - i. No update. On hold until zoning is complete
  - d. Historical Trail Update
    - i. Discovering episode airing on April 15th at 7:30
    - ii. James Schwaderer went to the site with Keith and Dan Palosaari for approximate distances on the boardwalk for approximate costs.
    - iii. Would need the \$500 JPA permit from DEQ for building the boardwalk over the wetland.
  - e. Zoning Ordinance Review
    - i. Looking at researching potential to allow processing facilities of a certain scale to promote a local food source.
    - ii. Main local processor in Jacobsville will be retiring next year.
  - f. Community Center Update
    - i. Chassell is now eligible to help the owner get the MEDC grant.

- g. Recreational Marijuana Law Opt Out?
  - i. Board wants to wait until they have a full board present
- h. Ray's TV Dangerous Building?
  - i. Keith and Brian checked the building, didn't find anything insecure.
  - Neighbors stated someone shoveled the roof
- i. Dog Park
  - i. Committee has been meeting
  - ii. Dog rules passed out for review, formed based off of other communities with dog parks.
  - iii. Brought up potential for breed restrictions. Committee agrees this would not be a good idea. Put a controversial spin on what otherwise would be a positive project.
  - iv. Suggestion to add a collar requirement
  - v. Check park open times and mirror for dog park
  - vi. Potential to put up post for donations where a certain percentage goes to the shelter.
  - vii. Small dog area and no size restriction area
- 8. New Business
  - a. 2018/2023 Recreation Plan Update
    - i. Merrie Carlock with the DNR had requested additional information. Lynn has submitted additional information. No word back yet.
  - b. PHFoundation Fitness Trail Grant
    - i. Keith submitted a proposal for a 10 station fitness trail on the lower Chassell Trails at the Heritage Center up to the 2k turnaround.
    - ii. Submitting materials to replace the S bridge on the trails as part of the proposal.
    - iii. The shop class at Chassell school will provide labor for the fitness stations and the bridge.
    - iv. Physiology professor at Tech will have students create videos on how to use all the fitness stations.
    - v. Project cost is \$14,500, with the Rec Millage providing 20% match.
    - vi. Decisions will be made this week on the grant recipients.
  - c. Risk Reduction Grant
    - i. GPS mapping of the Chassell Trail system and placing in Google Maps. Grant provides up to \$5,000 and no match requirement. Due May 31st. WUPPDR is currently undertaking a similar approach with other areas.
  - d. WUPPDR Community Marketing Grant
    - i. Awarded! \$3,400, 80/20 split Grant/Lion's Club. Getting new strawberry festival banner. New Centennial Park Sign. Dog Park Sign. Seasonal Light Pole Banners featuring key community assets. Accepted promoting the social media presence advertising.
  - e. Launch Site Engineering Study
    - i. Awarded to Traverse Engineering.
    - ii. Drafting a professional services agreement
    - iii. Traverse plans to start during May after melt. Plan to wrap up by July 30th.
