

Subject: REPORT: June 12, 2019 Pike Bay Remediation Committee Meeting

Barbara Gajewski, Many Waters Environmental, Iron River Michigan, met with us as an independent consultant to review our program and progress made since her firm's initial consultation and survey in 2013. She feels that our program to date has been reasonable and effective.

Discussion included definition of goals and best means of monitoring and controlling to date. It was noted that a systemic herbicide, Procella C, was available for the first time this year and was tried in certain areas of Pike Bay by PLM. If effective, it may result in longer term control. Also discussed was the broad outlook for invasives in the Upper Midwest, where they remain a threat.

Current lake levels and turbidity do not favor Many Waters doing a lake survey for us this summer--it is planned for 2020.
