<u>PUBLIC COMMENTS</u>: Jail Task Force Committee-Jim Tervo, Chassell representative reported how the recommendation for the County Jail came about. **Boundary Road**-Derrick Verron reported that the culvert next to his partially collapsed. Speaking with Ray Saatio from Portage Township reported that FEMA did give them money for only parts of Boundary Rd. and hopes the townships can work together to get the road fixed.

CORRESPONDENCE: Copy of letter from attorney Nick Daavettila to the Circuit Court Clerk to file a Motion for Entry of Default Judgment for court case against Vulaj.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: Fire Chief Judson reported 2 calls, 17 to date, both accidents. Over \$600,000-\$1 Million in donated gear went to 20 local fire departments on 9/28/19. Channel 3 TV covered the event. The fire department will go to Chassell School next week for Fire Prevention Week. The department received extrication tools and will train the department in the Spring. First Responders reported 10 calls, 80 to date. Motion by Dave Mattson supported by Dan Palosaari to accept applicant Wanda Walitalo, who is already trained as an EMT. M/C.

TOWNSHIP MAINTENANCE: Cole Smith reported that barricades will be put on **Old 41 Bridge** to be moved by DP. **Culvert by Old Ice Rink** on Hancock St. is blocked and needs additional cleaning by county. **Cemetery-**Superior Tree Farm has not started the seeding project. Wait till Spring. Motion by Lynn Gierke supported by Dave Mattson to spend up to \$1,000 for 2 windows in the Fire Hall. M/C.

Hamar & Chassell Painesdale-culvert being replaced. Old 41 Bridge-Kevin Harju will try to get background info for us. Pilgrim River Bridge-completion by Nov. 1st. Pot Holes by VFW, etc.-HCRC will look into. Keith Meyers reported that the Fitness Trail is coming together. A big thank you to Jim Tervo for getting the equipment to the trail. Volunteers have helped at 2 "work-bees" getting equipment in place. Portage Health Foundation-Community Wellness & Outdoor Recreation Grant received. The grant will provide new signage for both ski trail access points, will use GPS to map the trail system and website software upgrade. Chassell School woodshop will work on direction signage. Old Ice Rink-DPW and Severi Haajata removed old boards. PC requesting to use old rink for parking lot. Driveway entrance needs to be worked. Look for grant to salvage the old warming building. Public Hearing for Draft Zoning Ordinance, November 11, 6 pm at the Fire Hall. After reviewing the ordinance the PC only has 9 members which includes one board member. Therefore all seats are now filled.
